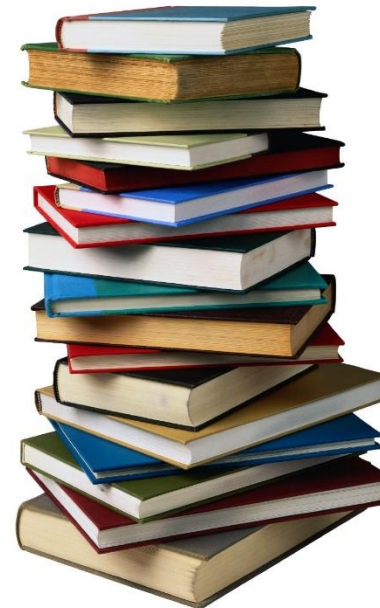

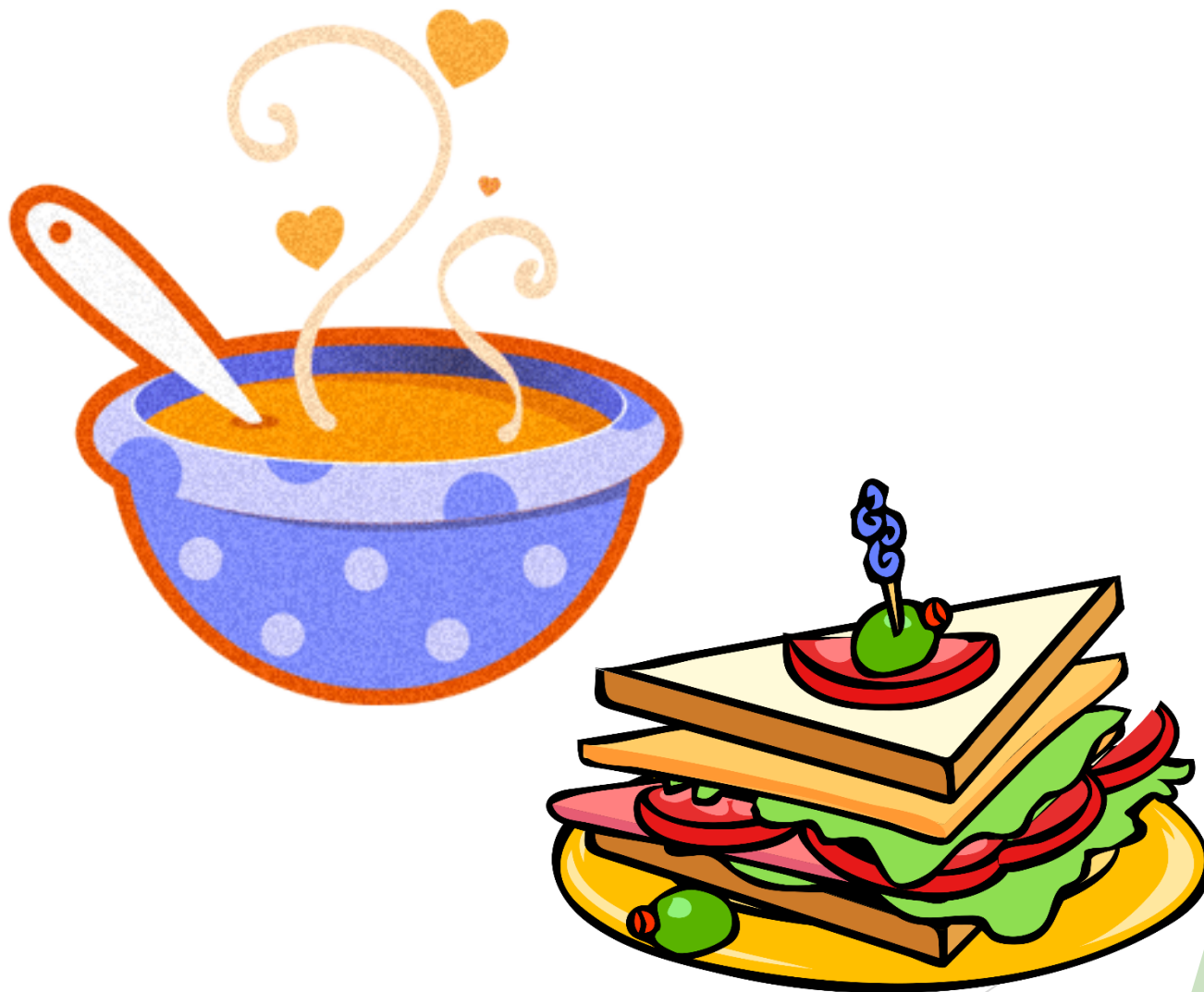
Project Outcome
